THE HOLY SPIRIT: (Part 4) Spiritual Renewal

1. Adam described three pictures of how Christ is formed in us. Paddlers, Drifters, and Windsurfers. Which one do you identify with the most?
2. The Paddlers would read Leviticus 11:44 and say, *"I'm going to paddle my way to earning my holiness."* Read this passage along with 2 Corinthians 6:17, & Romans 12:1-2. What does it mean to CONSECRATE or SACTIFY YOURSELF?
3. When we look at what it means for us to be holy, we know we're not perfect or without sin. So how then, are we holy? Read 1 Peter 1:13-16.
4. The Drifters would read Romans 7:18 and say, *"I can't do anything at all. Any human effort is opposed to grace."* What was Paul's point in his words to the Roman church here?
5. Can we make ourselves holy? Why or why not?
6. Windsurfers would read John 3:8. The Greek word for wind here is **PNEUMA**, which is the same word used for Spirit. Now that the Spirit's available, where is the Spirit blowing in your life?
7. The wind of the Spirit always tends to produce the Fruits of the Spirit. What's the practice or activity that when you engage in it, you find yourself becoming a more loving person or filled with joy?
